Summary of Position: The Worship Leader serves as a

member of the Summer Leadership Staff at NaCoMe. The Worship Leader will lead campers in musical worship and will plan the selection, performing, and leading Worship services. The Worship Leader is directly responsible for all aspects of the chapel Worship services. This includes musical instruments, vocals, sound booth, and slides.

Qualifications:

- A commitment to Christian principles and NaCoMe's mission and vision as a ministry of the PCUSA.
- Certification in First Aid and CPR.
- Able to play a musical instrument and sing vocals.
- Preferred previous experience in worship and/or A/V team setting.
- Has interest and experience working with children.
- Is willing to learn and instruct in multiple camp areas.
- Is able to traverse the multi-terrain campgrounds.
- Preferred previous lifeguard, ropes course, and/or summer camp work experience.

Responsibilities:

- Must attend Staff Training in its entirety unless prior arrangements have been made in advance with the Program Director.
- Preferred attendance at Ropes Course and/or Lifeguard department training.
- Manage planning and execution of chapel Worship services including summer camp, NaCoMe Family Camp weekend, and staff meetings.
- Coordinate with chapel speaker(s) for any set-up needs.
- Set up and tear down all chapel equipment.
- Organize and maintain department equipment.
- Facilitate scheduled activities for campers.
- Assist with all camp programming and other camp-wide activities as assigned.
- Assist the Program Director with various administrative and behind-the-scenes tasks as assigned (such as sorting and delivering camper mail, running PowerPoint slides during Worship, preparing/cleaning home-in-the-woods supplies, all camp games set-up, facilitation, and clean-up, etc.).
- Spend time with campers and family groups outside of direct work responsibilities.
- Work as a team with all other NaCoMe staff.
